

Dazzling Dogs Writing Contest Rules

1. You (the writer) must be a resident of the United States to enter the contest.
2. The article must be 800-1500 words and be about dogs. You must be the copyright holder and have the right to submit the work.
3. You must use IdeaWeaver and do an XML export as described in the instructions on the contest entry page to submit your entry.
4. You must submit your entry by March 31, 2008 Pacific Standard Time. No exceptions. (The contest form stops accepting entries at 12:00 midnight on April 1, so consider entering early, just to be safe.)
5. If we don't receive enough entries to publish the book of essays, we obviously won't give you a copy of the book. We reserve the right to save your entry aside and include it in another book, which may be associated with another contest. All winners will receive a free license for IdeaWeaver however. If we do publish your story in any book, we will send you a free copy of that book.
6. You (the writer) warrant that any submitted article does not contain libelous or defamatory information, and that anything presented as fact is accurate and complete.
7. You (the writer) warrants that you are honoring all outside agreements, oral and written, regarding non-disclosure, trade secrets, confidentiality, copyright, and licensing.
8. You (the writer) represent and warrants that you are the sole author of the article and that the article is original and does not infringe on any statutory or common law copyright, proprietary right, or any other right of any person or organization; that Writer has made no commitments with

any others regarding the article and its use, that the statements made in the article are true.

9. You (the writer), by entering the contest, relinquish to Logical Expressions, Inc. one-time print rights, excerpt rights, and anthology rights for the article and all of its contents. You also give Logical Expressions, Inc. permission to excerpt parts of the article for promotional purposes without further compensation to Writer.

10. You (the writer) agree and understands that Logical Expressions, Inc. reserves the right to edit article for grammar, content, format and length, and otherwise make changes to the article prior to publication.

11. You (the writer) agree that Logical Expressions, Inc. is in no way obligated to publish the article and may for any reason decide not to use the article.
